

The I Want the Kit (IWTK) Program offers free, accurate, and confidential specimen self-collection and CLIA certified lab-based testing for sexually transmitted infections. Pregnancy self-tests are also available for those assigned female at birth. These services are currently available for residents of Alaska, Arizona, Idaho, Iowa, Kansas, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oklahoma, Oregon, South Dakota, Utah, Washington, and Wyoming.
